## Requirements for Ordination to the Rank of Sub-Deacon

## Candidates for the rank of Sub-Deacon are expected to meet the following requirements:

- 1) The candidate must fulfill all minimum requirements for the Reader & Chanter.
- 2) The candidate must not be less than 21 years of age.
- 3) The candidate must show at least 80% church attendance in a single parish church the year prior to ordination.
- 4) The candidate must be consistent in repentance and confession, and receive the recommendation of his father of confession.
- 5) The candidate must have served faithfully as a Reader for at least 3 years.
  - a. Note: Until January 2022 this will not be required.
- 6) The candidate must show proficiency of rites that change according to the liturgical cycle, such as:
  - a. The customary fractions that are to be prayed on any particular day, feast, or seasons.
  - b. The litanies to be said in a service on any particular day, feast, or season as well as the accompanying deaconate responsibilities that change accordingly. (i.e. Sick, Travelers, Oblations, Departed)
- 7) The candidates must pass a written exam to ensure a minimum level of liturgical knowledge. This exam will be primarily based on the book Christ in the Eucharist by Fr. Tadros Malaty, but will also include questions about general liturgical knowledge.
